


Strike Jamb Assembly











C400ST Angle Clip






C410ST Floor Clip













# Parts List




Step 1
Check dimensions and square of rough opening.
Cut vertical jambs if necessary.

\*Frames may be shipped with extra length for field cutting to allow for floor deflections.




**Step 2**Slip H-Mullion Header and Vertical Jambs into Opening and attach together.




Step 3

Install snap-in header, followed by the strike jamb.




Step 4

Install glass pocket in strike jamb, followed by the glass base.




## Step 5

Install intermediate vertical glass jamb (if required) and secure to glass base and H-mullion with 4 each C406ST clips (refer to clipping diagram.) Insert glass pocket in glass jamb followed by glass pocket headers into the H-mullion.



Step 6

Install mid-height glass base (if required) with four C406ST clips (reference clipping diagram.) Install glass stops on glass base and midheight base.



### Step 7

Attach hinge jamb to drywall partition, then install door stops to hinge and strike jamb.

Attach hinge jamb with 1-5/8" drywall screws through the sheetrock and into the segmented frame stud. Use a minimum of 3 screws per stud segment per side.

Attach door stops to hinge and strike jambs by hooking inside leg (nearest door) on receiver tab and lightly tap with rubber mallet toward outer edge of stop.
